

## SAFETY FIRST

- Please do not pet or feed the horses in the pastures or turnout areas. Come into the stables for a barn tour for the safety and comfort of all guests and horses.
- Please do not enter any stall, pastures, or turnout areas without a staff member's permission.
- All riders are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet. Certified helmets are provided at the stables for no extra charge.
- Riders are not permitted to ride double (more than one rider per horse) at any time.
- We recommend that all riders wear long pants and boots with a low heel. No skirts, dresses or open-toed shoes.
- Riders may not use cell phones or cameras while mounted.
- Alcohol and smoking are prohibited at the stables.

## DIRECTIONS

Oglebay is located in Wheeling, West Virginia on Rt. 88 N, just 4 miles off I-70 at exit 2A. The stables are located directly on Route 88, on the left.

- 1 hour from Pittsburgh via I-79 S to I-70 W to Wheeling Exit 2A.
- 2 1/2 hours from Columbus via I-70 E to Wheeling Exit 2A.
- 3 hours from Cleveland via I-77 S to I-70 E to Wheeling Exit 2A.

## ABOUT US

Oglebay is dedicated to providing enjoyable horse experiences for riders of all ages and skill levels. We offer trail rides, pony rides, lessons, EAGALA services, camps, and more.

Trail rides are conducted on wide trails through the woods. All other rides take place in our indoor and outdoor riding arenas. The facility also offers a heated viewing room, lounge, and restrooms.

## ELIGIBILITY

While we strive to serve every person who would like to ride, there are several requirements.

- Riders must weigh under 220 pounds.
- All riders must sign a liability release. Riders under 18 years of age will need a custodial parent or guardian to sign the release. We are happy to fax or mail release forms if minors are not accompanied by a parent.
- Participants must disclose physical and/or mental conditions that would affect his/her safety and ability to ride a horse. For riders with special needs, see EAGALA services for non-mounted activities.
- Any guest under 13 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- Riders under the influence of alcohol or appearing to be chemically impaired will not be permitted to ride.

## SERVICES

We offer many different services to meet the needs of our guests. All rides are by reservation and space is limited. We recommend that you call at least 48 hours in advance to make a reservation.

Large groups or classroom sessions should be arranged two weeks in advance to allow for staffing, horses, and equipment. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your reservation time to allow for safety and equipment preparation.

### SEASONAL TRAIL RIDES

Take a relaxing, guided trail ride through the woods at Oglebay. Trail rides are conducted at a walking gait. Weather permitting.

*Riders must be at least 9 years of age.*

*\$50.00\*/per person/per hour*

*Depending on weather and trail conditions, trail rides can be scheduled year round. Availability is determined by the Equine Operations Staff only.*

### LESSONS

Learn to ride English or Western in our indoor and outdoor arenas. All lessons include grooming and tacking up. Riders must be at least 7 years of age.

*Private lessons: \$45.00\*/per rider/per hour*

*\$30.00\*/per rider/per half hour*

*Group lessons: \$30.00\*/per rider/per hour*

### PONY RIDES

Perfect for the littlest cowboys and cowgirls!

*Age 2 and up. \$10.00\*/per rider/per 10 minutes*

## EAGALA SERVICES

A non-mounted therapeutic service for individuals seeking growth in mental health and human development.
