OGLEBAYFEST PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The parade will begin at the Good Zoo at 9:30 a.m., Saturday, October 5th, 2019 and will run past Schenk Lake, Wilson Lodge, Park Office, Mansion Museum, and return to the Good Zoo parking lot.

- 1. All entries in the parade must be registered.
- 2. For safety reasons no items are to be thrown to the spectators.
- 3. Only items of non-commercial and non-political nature may be handed to spectators.
- 4. No political or controversial issues may be represented or alluded to in any way, by any participant. The sole exception will be one float representing each political party.
- 5. No candidate for political office may participate in the parade except on their party's float.
- 6. Elected officials who are not currently candidates for any elected office may participate elsewhere in the parade.
- 7. All drivers of motorized vehicles must have a valid driver's license and be 18 years of age or older.
- 8. Helmets must be worn by all youth under the age of 18 riding horseback, bicycles, roller blades, scooters or skateboards.
- 9. All youth 2 and under riding horseback must be on a lead.
- 10. Stallions are not permitted in the parade.
- 11. All horses must be peopled and crowd experienced, and safe for all concerned.
- 12. All equine entries need a negative Cogins test; entries from WV must have a test within two years, from anywhere else a test within one year. Out of state horses need a Certificate of Veterinarian inspection.
- 13. Smoking or drinking of alcoholic beverages will not be permitted.
- 14. All units must stay within 40 feet of the unit in front of them.
- 15. Any entry violating rules or behaving in an unsafe manner will be subject to immediate removal from the parade by any law enforcement official or parade worker.
- 16. All laws and Park Commission Regulations must be obeyed.
- 17. In any interpretation of parade rules, the Wheeling Park Commission management's decision shall be final.

2019 OGLEBAYFEST PARADE PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

Be it known that the undersigned intends to be a Participant in the Oglebayfest Parade held in Oglebay Park, Wheeling, West Virginia on Saturday, October 5th 2019, which said Parade is operated by the Wheeling Park Commission. Participant acknowledges that he/she has read all the rules and regulations as promulgated by the Wheeling Park Commission regarding safety measures, and understands their content.

Be if further known that Participant does hereby accept and acknowledge full and total responsibility for his/her actions and activities during the course of the Parade route, and does accept and acknowledge the fact that the Wheeling Park Commission expressly offers no indemnification to Participant for any injury that may befall a member of the Participant's entry or the Parade audience as the result of Participant's activity.

Participant expressly agrees to assume full responsibility for his/her activity that involves the offering, delivery, or distribution, in any manner whatsoever, of goods or candies to members of the public who constitute the Parade audience.
